Feedback is recorded for review by relevant staff including the CEO and Board of Directors. Feedback is responded to promptly and appropriately.
- Aoibhneas Domestic Abuse Support for Women and Children prepares financial reports consistent with the requirements of the Charities Act 2009 and the Charities Regulator and produces a Statement of Recommended Practice concerning the extent to which control of the organisation is independent of its funding sources.
